- Queen's Hospital as major acute hospital
- Whipps Cross and King George Hospitals remain as district general hospitals (DGHs)
- Independent Sector Treatment Centre (ISTC) at King George Hospital

**Option 2**

- Queen's Hospital as major acute hospital
- Whipps Cross Hospital - emergency focus
- King George Hospital - elective focus
- ISTC at King George Hospital

**Option 3**

- Queen's Hospital as major acute hospital
- Whipps Cross Hospital - elective focus
- King George Hospital - emergency focus
- ISTC at King George Hospital

**Option 4**

- Queen's Hospital as major acute hospital
- Whipps Cross Hospital - full DGH
- King George Hospital – ambulatory care centre<sup>1</sup>
- ISTC at King George Hospital

- Whipps Cross Hospital – ambulatory care centre
